

Centre for Environment PhD Scholarships (3)

Applications are invited from outstanding students for three inaugural Centre for Environment PhD scholarships at the University of Tasmania.

The Centre for Environment was established in 2005 to facilitate interdisciplinary research across the environment theme at UTAS. Three PhD scholarships are available in the following areas commencing in 2006:

- Sources, processes and impact of nutrient movement through a multiple-use terrestrial landscape
- Nutrient budgeting in a coastal estuarine system
- Social, economic and institutional pre-conditions for successful catchment-scale management of water yield and quality

The scholarships will be supported by an APA- equivalent stipend of \$18,837 per annum, non-taxable, for up to three years and will be awarded on a competitive basis. Applicants must hold or expect to obtain a first-class or good upper second-class honours degree or equivalent.
