

Faculty of Education Half-Fee Scholarships for International Students

The Faculty of Education is committed to supporting International students pursuing Masters and/or Doctorate research degrees at the University of Tasmania. To assist and encourage our students, the Faculty offers a number of Half-Fee Scholarships for International Students. The scholarships aim to enhance students' learning experiences and facilitate the timely completion of their degree.

Half-Fee scholarships are available to both new and continuing students in the Faculty. Details on the scholarship and the application and selection process follow:

Value

- The Half-Fee scholarship will reduce by half of the tuition fees payable for studies in a Faculty of Education higher degree by research (M Ed Research, PhD or EdD).

Duration:

- The Half-Fee scholarship is awarded for up to three years of research higher degree candidature, subject to satisfactory progress as reported in annual reviews.

Eligibility

- Successful application for enrolment in a Faculty of Education research higher degree (M Ed Research, PhD or EdD), or
- Current enrolment in a Faculty of Education research higher degree (M Ed Research, PhD or EdD) with demonstrated satisfactory progress in candidature
- Applicants must not be in receipt of any other scholarships

Selection criteria:

- Potential for contribution to established or emerging research areas for the Faculty:
 - Mathematics Education
 - Literacy Education
 - Leadership
 - Education, Health and Well-being
 - Teaching and Learning in Teacher Education
 - Curriculum and pedagogy

Other areas of education research will also be considered.

- Demonstrated benefits the scholarship would provide to the applicant
- Academic achievement, to date
- Referee reports

Application process:

Future students must submit the following:

- Completed and signed scholarship application form - www.research.utas.edu.au/gr/scholarships/international_scholarships.htm - responding to the scholarship selection criteria.
- A full application for a research higher degree in the Faculty, including a CV, certified academic transcripts, proof of English Language, two referee reports and a brief outline of the proposed research project (see www.utas.edu.au for application forms and required documentation)

Current students can be nominated by their supervisor or may elect to apply for the scholarship independently. In either case, current students must submit the following:

- Completed and signed application form - www.research.utas.edu.au/gr/scholarships/international_scholarships.htm - responding to the scholarship selection criteria.
- Two referee reports, using the template provided at www.research.utas.edu.au/gr/scholarships/international_scholarships.htm
At least one referee must be a current supervisor of the applicant. Applicants may elect to use a referee report from their initial degree application as their second referee report.

Selection process:

- The selection process will be administered by the Faculty of Education Research Committee's Scholarship and Prize Selection Sub-Committee.
- Membership of the Scholarship and Prize Selection Sub-Committee will include an experienced researcher with relevant expertise and who is preferably a member of the Faculty of Education International Committee.
- The decision of Scholarship and Prize Selection Sub-Committee pertaining to the awarding or withdrawing of the Faculty of Education's Half-Fee Scholarships for International Students will be final.
